EVENTS ORGANIZED BY ASSOCIATIONS OF PERSONS WITH SCI AND THE SPINAL CORD SECTION OF THE HELLENIC SOCIETY OF PRM

The Hellenic Spinal Cord section of the Hellenic Physical & Rehabilitation Medicine society (HSPRM), warmly welcomes the 5th of September with the hope that it will be a unique chance for enhancing public awareness concerning Spinal Cord Injury. What makes us very proud and even more enthousiastic is that our logo (created, designed and crafted by Konstantinos Katagas) took the approval of ISCoS to be the unique logotype for the International SCI Day.

Our actions before, during and after the First SCI Awareness day, will take place in the **three major towns of Greece (Athens, Thessaloniki and Patra).** In all three towns, there will be a press release concering the day, sound messages to the local and national radio and tv channels, and references to newspapers and internet. Additionally several interviews will be given by members of HSPRM and individuals with SCI.

For ten days, the logo and a small message concerning SCI day will be appearing **on public transport vehicles and bus stops** in Thessaloniki. A **poster, information brochures and shirts** will be made and will be delivered by volunteers the pre-event week at Patras main square.

The **entertainment events** will start on 1st of September at Faros, a central and popular place of Patras, where several artists will perform in a festival concerning the DAY. Program will include dance performances, live bands, Jogglers and DJ sets. During the above events **ISCoS videos** will be projected.

On the 5th of September, the **White Tower**, a timeless symbol and point of reference for Thessaloniki, North Greece and the entire country, will be **skylighted with the logo** of the day. There will also be 2 or 3 **information desks** at the beach for the delivery of relevant brochures by voluteers. In the gulf of Thessaloniki two small **sailing boats will be sailing with the logo** of the day on their mast, driven by people with paraplegia.

There, there will be an **information desk/booth** and a special reference to the SCI day will be made by relevant brochure and ISCoS video screen projection.
